I Do My Part

Have you ever thought of the word "inexhaustible" in connexion with God? It has a pleasant sound, has it not? Pleasant in the sense that with Him, His Omnipotence, Omniscience and Omnipresence are literally an illimitable source of ALL GOOD on which

you and I and all other people and creatures can draw without any fear of depleting it. However, it is not quite as simple as it sounds, nor as it appears to be to the man in the street.

We have to think of it in connection with the spiritual side of life, for before we can look for the manifestation in our bodies and affairs of all that God is and has, it is necessary for us to establish contact with Him. This approach can be a very simple thing to accomplish; all that is required of us is that we grow into the consciousness of Him as our all-sufficiency in all things. If we have a child like faith it is easy, but very few of us are blessed with that, so when we try to condense the spiritual Force of Love into visibility we meet with many setbacks. If we could accept *in toto* in our mental, emotional and material affairs the idea of God manifest as all good on every plane of consciousness, we should all reflect perfect health and happiness and abundant supply to share and to spare.

However, if we look around us, we shall not see much evidence of this complete state of well-being. It is of course true that there are people expressing health, and others showing forth harmony, as well as many who manifest prosperity, but where is the individual who enjoys all three of these blessings? Go into any home, and you will not find him for he is far to seek. Wherever you look one of these qualities - at least - will always be missing and the question is, "Why should this be so? Why cannot God give us wholeness, and bring to our conscious minds the realisation of Himself as our mental, emotional and physical fullness?" He is impotent where this is concerned because, in spite of what we may say to the contrary, if any of these qualities are lacking, it is so because we have failed to accept them on trust. There is always something wanting in relation to harmony. It may be that the husband irritates his wife, or that she worries him; with respect to health someone may say, "It is nothing to do with me personally; this one or that one upsets me, with the result that my bodily rhythm and tranquillity are disturbed and the condition of sickness ensues". Where an absence of prosperity obtains one hears the lament, "If only I had more education, a better background, rich parents or wealthy relations I should be able to *accept* abundance for myself; but as it is I cannot see any channel through which God can manifest for me as affluence."

All these are very limiting ideas, and a complete denial of the truth that whatever we need is already within us, within our unseen selves, a part of our spiritual consciousness, an inexhaustible supply, not of just what we absolutely need, but of the infinite riches of our father. Nevertheless, in order ourselves to participate in these we must experience that quickening of the spirit that comes with the knowledgeable faith that enables him that attains it, to say: "I KNOW THAT IT IS TRUE". This certainty arises out of personal experience; it is no mere belief but a deep inner conviction, and as long as any discordant condition persists this has not been achieved; there is still a sense of separation with the consequent absence of the thing desired.

What, then, can a man do if he wants happiness in his home and his wife upsets him? And what steps can a person take who is suffering from illness through the disturbing influence of someone in his environment? Or what action is open to the individual who may *have* rich relations who will not help him? None of these persons has anything at all to do! We are all selfsufficient; we have, contained within ourselves, the spiritual substance that has but one thought, one desire, which is to press itself out into livingness in our homes as harmony, in our bodies as health, and in our affairs as prosperity *as soon* as we have risen sufficiently above the place, conditions, circumstances, appearances or people that are confounding us. It is we, by our own reactions, who are limiting ourselves. We are shutting out the things we want because of people who are nothing but our growing pains, and it is only by and through our overcoming that we shall attain to that quality of consciousness, that realisation of the fullness of spirit within us, that will lead to the externalisation of all that we need.

I think it is worth it! Even if poverty, unhappiness and lack manifest for a time, the experience that will ultimately make of you independent entities, self-assured, free as the air you breathe, is well worth going through if it gives you the awareness of your oneness with God, so lifting all mental, emotional and physical burdens from your shoulders and flooding your homes with harmony, your bodies with health, and your affairs with prosperity, sunshine and success.

Think of it like this. Suppose you were a poor student who, having just passed your matric, were about to start out in life and someone came along and said: "I see you have excellent abilities that are capable of unlimited development if they are given a fair chance; what would you like to do? I am prepared to finance you, I will pay for your further education, clothe and feed you" what would your reaction be? Would you accept that offer and work as hard as within you lay, to profit by the opportunity and make a success of yourself? If I knew anything of people you would do your best sitting up at night studying, starting again early in the morning, without counting the cost in either time or effort, knowing that not the present, with it stress and strain, was important, but the future which had in store your success in your chosen métier, the complete fulfilment of your ambitions and your innermost heart's desire.

As far as your professors were concerned, they would be quite impersonal, and if you did not come up to scratch you would be failed and you would have to do the work over again. You would accept this; but when it comes to God we feel differently, we expect Him to pour into our lives everything He is without effort on our part. We are not concerned as to the type of *lives* we are leading, we are content to *pray* for – but not to earn – our prosperity, health or happiness, and we are affronted when we do not receive what we have asked for. We wonder why the good does not come to pass, forgetting that it is we who are limiting Him and that he can do no more than He has already done, for has He not said, "all that I have, is thine"?

He has placed no limit upon this, all that He is and has is ours in whatever form and to whatever degree we desire, but we – not He – are the ones who set our health, happiness or prosperity free; we alone are responsible for our mental attitude towards these things, and if they ever appear to be receding from us, that is because we, by our doubts and fears, have brought this to pass. We are confronted with a spiritual Law which we *have* to accept, and this we can do only as we expand our consciousnesses to such an extent that we are enabled to understand It and receive It. We should welcome our growing pains, for it is by and through them that our faith will eventually be established on solid ground.

We cannot afford to deviate from the path; cannot, as some people tell me they want to do, give up the struggle, and live lives of spiritual indolence, for, within us, permeating our entire beings, is God's hypersensitive Law, which we must obey implicitly if we would demonstrate.

You all know what you want from life – not the crumbs from the table but happiness in yourselves and in your relations with others, vitally healthy bodies, the freedom to come and to go as you please, abundant prosperity to share and to spare; and to achieve this, you have to earn it. You have to follow Christ's simple teachings, loving, forgiving, turning the other cheek, not judging by appearances, and above all, you have to recognise that you are temples of the living God, that His Kingdom is within you and is your All-sufficiency in all things.

You have not the strength to carry this out on your own, so ask of God. Ask Him to teach you how to grow, to test you so that you may increase in stature, and to prove you so that you may indeed qualify as His children recognising His Presence, and the indwelling Christ, ever working through you and for you. I know how much you want this realisation, how you yearn to be free from circumstances and dependence upon people, and these are not your personal desires, they are the Christ within you, calling to each of you to arise in consciousness, thereby taking your minds off the negative appearances that bind you and destroy you.

As you listen to these promptings within your own souls, rejoice in the knowledge that they are the Voice of God saying, "I want to fill you full with radiant health, peace and happiness, and with abundant prosperity to share and to spare in My service".

The average individual does not listen to these desires at all, he hearkens rather to the clamouring of outside conditions and his emotional state shows on what he is focusing his attention. If discords persist he becomes disappointed, frustrated and disgruntled; if his good hangs fire a restlessness begins to stir in him, he feels that he is just a dreamer of dreams because the things he wants do not show up, either in his life or his affairs, and, as he worries more and more about this, his state of consciousness, that which he is registering emotionally, is reflected to an ever greater and greater extent throughout his whole being and all that concerns him.

I am often asked, "How does one pray? How must I pray?", and I answer that prayer is not so much a matter of words – though these are useful – but a mental and emotional attunement of the one praying with the Spirit of Love within him. It is an inner relaxation, a spiritual acceptance, the identifying of the individual

with the plan that God, *his own spirit*, is trying to express through the particular channel that he is. It is rather as if I (representing the Spirit) picked up a telephone and rang you at home to tell you of your good fortune in coming into a legacy. You, having listened very attentively to what I had to say, would be happy and elated; there would be a lifting of your state of consciousness the instant you heard the good news, and no matter how disgruntled or wretched you had been before, you would feel light and free, you would be re-energised and revitalised as the result of my

message. That is what would happen if I, a human being, gave good news to you; yet God, the Spirit of Love, is doing this for you and me and all mankind continually.

If His will were not for our highest good there would be nothing on earth that we could do about it. And as a matter of fact we should not even *want* to do anything, we should all be consciously or unconsciously resigned to struggling through life until death released us. Your present restlessness is the "divine discontent" that God inspires in His "temples" to act as a prod, impelling us to take our mental emotional and material tests so that we may, having refused everything but perfection, receive His inexhaustible flood of All-good.

There are people who are under the impression that we of the School do not have to make any effort to attain our good – health, happiness or prosperity – but this is a fallacy; we have to strive precisely as you do to achieve the consciousness of God as Supply, and what is more we know that we cannot afford to fall short where this is concerned. We are our own examiners, our own teachers, too, and we keep ourselves ever on the path because we may not permit ourselves to fail.

What is love asking of *you* at this present? Just that you listen, not outside to the problem, but to the Voice within that is telling you to transmute the negative seeming into the positive reality; that is asking you, because of Its desire for your wellbeing in all things, to put aside sorrow and depression and to follow the admonition of the Christ, so giving happiness to those that mourn, health to them that are sick, and prosperity to all in want. There are thousands for whom you can pray, people to whom you can give, by and through your prayers, all that you crave for yourselves. As you pass this on, unselfishly, you will awaken to the realisation that it is not you, the little man, who is doing this but that it is God within you, opening His Hands and using your mental, emotional and spiritual hands to give to you, through you, not according to your needs, not even according to your deserts, but in accordance with the inexhaustible measure of His Bounty and His Love.

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If thou seest anything in thyself which may make thee proud, look a little further and thou shall find enough to humble thee; if thou be wise, view the peacock's feathers with his feet, and weigh thy best parts with thy imperfections.

There are no accidents

There sometimes spoken the above words to friends, and the reaction has been immediate incredulity. Yet let us consider them. What is an accident? Something that is supposed to happen outside the Law. But can we get "outside" the Law?

The whole universe with its planets and stars held in their courses, day and night, the tides of oceans, light and dark, heat and cold, electricity, all tell us of law and order. In our own lives I think it will be agreed that we live on different "levels" of consciousness which produce their own results. At the lower end of the scale we are "down in the dumps", and at the higher end of the scale we say we are "in our seventh heaven". There are many levels in between, and our experiences are in accordance with them – they cannot be otherwise because all is in accordance with Law. Law is divine and infinite – we cannot escape it, we cannot get "outside" it.

Following the teachings of Truth, meditating, and making contact with the Divine Mind at the beginning of each day sets us on a high level and we find our experiences are more and more harmonious and "accidents" do not occur. In fact, we *seem* to have risen above Law. This is not a contradiction, for all is still governed by all-inclusive Divine Law, but at the higher end of the scale the Bible terms it "grace", as it is given in Romans 6:14, "For sin shall not have dominion over you: for ye are not under the law, but under grace". Meditating upon this quotation, I feel it means that influences which seem adverse cannot touch us when we live above man-made laws; they cannot touch us when we express love as much as possible and thus "fulfil the law". We are then receptive to "grace" which transcends "law" as we think of it on this human level.

Sometimes in a case of sickness there is what appears to be a miraculous recovery. This is really no "miracle" but a breakthrough from a higher level of Law to the Child of God needing healing. All is still governed by Law.

We may well ask at this point, "How can we live on the higher levels of consciousness?" One answer is, "The truth shall make you free" (John 8:32) – free from sickness, lack, unhappiness and "accidents". This truth is simply to realise our oneness with Divinity and our inseparability from Divinity. We are "Ideas in Mind" – and what could be safer than an idea in mind? With the understanding that there are no "accidents", we do not experience "accidents".

People argue in this wise: "A friend of mine was on the pavement when a lorry jumped the curb and knocked her down." I ask, "Did that friend *understand* that there are no 'accidents'? Had she been *realising* her oneness with God, Divine Principle, Law?" We create our own environment and draw to ourselves the effects of our thoughts and actions. All IS cause and effect – Law.

Another point of truth is that we are all in our right places, and the bit of road or pavement that I am using is not wanted by anyone else – we only have to realise this truth. If it is necessary for someone to stand on a chair to reach up to something, he or she will not slip off if there is the conviction of oneness with the infinite strength, poise, balance, guidance, etc. We have to discipline ourselves in thought, word and deed, but it is well worth while, and so let us sing with the Psalmist, "Open Thou mine eyes, that I may behold wondrous things out of Thy law" (Ps. 119:18). And prove for ourselves that there are no "accidents".

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While it is futile for man to try to oppose the power of gigantic waterfalls, he can yet harness them to his use. The energy that lies hidden in those swiftly moving waters can be converted into electrical power, which, in turn, can be carried by cable to light distant towns, to turn its machinery, and bring prosperity to men. In the same way, while we cannot successfully oppose life, yet hidden powers enable us to overcome and work through all experiences, until we become master of our life, through mastery over ourselves.

Think on these things

Probably most of us if we were asked, would say that we loved beauty, but do we prove it in our daily lives?

All the destructive emotions are ugly, and how many of us can say truthfully that we never give

way to them? How often do we lose our tempers for instance, and so say and do things which we bitterly regret when we have regained our poise? Anger is ugly, and what it produces is also ugly. Not only that, but it injures us physically, mentally, and spiritually. And so often we become angry for such trivial reasons! This means a loss of power and dignity. We should learn self-control by looking to the spirit within us. As Vera Stanley Alder says: "One learns to control in measure only as one learns to be controlled by that which is higher than oneself." Then let us allow ourselves to be governed by God and not by our less worthy emotions.

Hatred is another ugly thing, and one which distorts our judgement. And hate breeds hate. We should keep our minds stayed on God. As students of Truth we know that hatred must be banished if we are to live richly and fully. If we hate we may or may not hurt the person towards whom our hatred is directed, but we certainly hurt ourselves. We separate ourselves from God when we hate any of his children. We block up the channel through which his goodness flows to us. There may be certain circumstances in which we feel it is impossible not to hate someone who has injured one dear to us. We might have forgiven an injury to ourselves, but it is far more difficult to forgive an injury to a loved one. In such a case we must go to God for help, for to him all things are possible. We must ask him to cleanse our hearts and minds of this ugly thing.

Greed, injustice, selfishness, and intolerance are all to be avoided by the beauty lover. They create disharmony amongst individuals and nations. We must be ready to share what we have; to be just in all things; to be unselfish; and to be tolerant. Jealousy, too, is an ugly thing. We should rejoice in the successes of our neighbours as if they were our own. It is foolish to be envious because they have more than we, for everything we need has already been provided for us in God's Kingdom, and our faith will bring it into manifestation.

St. Paul tells us to think on the things that are true, honourable, just, pure, lovely, and of good report. If our thoughts are concentrated on beauty our lives will be beautiful, since our actions are the result of our thoughts, and as we think, so we are.

Beauty is to be found on every side by those with seeing eyes, hearing ears, and understanding hearts. There is beauty in an aged face glowing with love and kindliness; in the violent crashing of waves on the seashore during a storm; in the setting of the sun and the rising of the moon. There is the beauty of words, of pictures, and of music. Even the little yellow weed which we uproot from our gardens is an exquisite thing when we see it through a microscope. God's Law of Good

Frustrated in mind, physically ill, and lacking in supply, desperately I turn to the Love within me to know why, for so long, I seem to be separated from the Good which I know it is the Father's only desire to bestow upon me. I know that God's Law of Good is outworking in the

lives of many for I see evidence all around me, yet at the present moment in my life there seems to be so much to cause me pain and suffering.

I know that God's law of Good must work perfectly and therefore these conditions in my life are no part of it. I accept that God has a perfect plan for His Universe and all in it and that His Law works perfectly in spite of the appearances which impress themselves upon me so unhappily.

Why is it, then, that in spite of my acceptance of the desire of God to express Himself as Good in my life, I seem to be so separated from His Law at this moment? Why is it that I seem to be so helpless in overcoming these conditions when I know that the Power but awaits my recognition to be used of me?

As I search within myself for the answers to my puzzlement, I review my life in retrospect and I become aware that I have met other situations like these and always God led me out of the wilderness. I realise that though the present situation is bigger than anything that I have ever experienced before, I am also aware that I am in a position to view things differently and that I am spiritually stronger to cope with them. I have learned that if I am to grow spiritually I must be ready to accept these experiences that come into my life no matter how hard they appear, and that they can prove stepping stones to greater knowledge and understanding. From this I see that God never fails and that I need to be more trusting, so I quietly affirm with conviction and feeling: *I am more trusting and I accept that God's Law of Good is even now working in my life to fulfil itself only as Harmony, Health and Prosperity.*

Next, I ask myself if this sense of separation persists because my mind has become anchored to a wrong conception of finite time. As I review the things that are happening I find myself steadily unwinding the fetters of this wrong conception in my mind and I clearly affirm: In God there is only the Eternal Now and spiritually I am one with him NOW. As I let the light of this Truth illumine my consciousness I am aware of the lessening of the darkness and despair that previously appeared to reign in my life and affairs. Then, carrying it further, I realise that not only must I free myself of this limited idea of time, but I must also set to work to lift up many other limited ideas that could be holding up my demonstration. As I search within myself, I become aware of many wrong ideas which I thought I had eliminated but had again crept back into my consciousness. Forcefully I deny that such negative feelings as impatience, fear and frustration have any place in God's plan for me and see that they are without power in my life.

As the light of Truth floods my consciousness I feel the tensions of mind and body being released and replaced by a glorious feeling of renewed faith and gratitude. I really feel that God's Law of Good is working in and through me and that there is nothing more for me to do but to keep the switch on by living constantly in this realisation. Should my thoughts move away from this realisation, I bring them back immediately by affirming: *God's goodness, God's power, God's health and God's prosperity are the only true reality in my life.* Carefully I watch my emotions (feelings) and my reactions to events around me until I subconsciously follow what is required of me personally in working with God's Law of Good. By doing good to others, by doing my work well, and in generally living up to the highest within me I foster a feeling of "Good" within that tells me that I am attuned to the Power required to transform my affairs.

I also become aware that much of the "little self" that obtruded into the picture has disappeared and that the Higher Self is now in command. Whereas before my thoughts only reached a certain level, I find that they now go much deeper and clearly discern the Truth. I see how little avail my own efforts of human will have proved in overcoming my problem for, time and time again, I had failed although I had made every effort sincerely and hopefully to change the conditions that presented themselves.

Thus I arrive at a stage when there is a complete "letting go" to God, when everything is handed over in complete trust. If there is still a seeming delay I repeat the affirmation, *God, I am trusting,* and I say it over many times. With this comes the realisation of what a big part self-pride has played in obstructing and delaying my good from reaching me. How difficult I found it to shed the grand seeming cloak of pride and replace it with the unassuming garment of humility. How hard I found it to take the questioning of fellow men who could only judge the outer appearances of failure by their human standards.

Very much as a radio set becomes attuned to its right station, so all the discord and clamour of a separation in consciousness gives way to the sweet harmony of being attuned to the law of good. Peace and love now reign within and I give thanks for this realisation that God's law of good ever pours forth to bless all as I recall the lines of the poet;

> "Nay, Nay, 'twas not the law that failed: 'Twas thou who trusted not. Is law alone for me to keep? Nay, thou must do thy part

Thou art to ask for naught but good, And, asking, never doubt. That is the law that thou must keep – Seek good, and ever believe. When thou hast kept this law of good, Then ask: and thou wilt receive."

- 8. When an unexpected blessing or some good comes to us, we turn first to God and give thanks to Him as the Source of ALL Good.

- 9. If people appear to misunderstand, misjudge or mistreat us, readily forgive them, beholding love (God) in each individual concerned.
- 10. Instead of looking to our employers, our debtors or other human sources, we look directly to Truth in us for Supply.
- In taking practical steps to work out our problems, we must feel and know, that we have done our share and therefore we are justified in confidently expecting God to supply our need.
- 12. We do not indulge in open or mental criticism of a destructive nature regarding our fellowmen.
- 13. We put first things first and refuse to let minor irritations and problems take our time and energy.
- 14. We make every effort to see that our conversations reflect a loving, tolerant, understanding and gracious attitude.
- 15. We exercise wise judgement in spending and using money and other resources at our command; knowing that we are thus opening the way for more and greater good in our lives.
- 16. We place ourselves, our loved ones, and our affairs in God's care and we do not dictate to him the manner in which the blessings desired should manifest.
- 17. When we fall short in our understanding of Truth and make mistakes, we do not waste time in self condemnation and worry, but accept the experience as indicating an opportunity for greater growth.

- 18. We make it a habit to speak words of cheer and silently pray for a friend or loved one who is facing a serious problem. We do not sympathise NEGATIVELY.

- 20. We have no right to be justifiably angry about anything. We must follow the warning "What is that to thee? Follow thou ME."
- 21. We let go of all outgrown ideas, attitudes of mind, and conditions that may be hindrances to our progress.
- 22. We are convinced that God not only can, but does bless us through many channels other than our own regular income.
- 23. In all our human associations, we conscientiously conduct ourselves in the realisation that, as Truth students, we should do all in our power to add to the happiness and well-being of others.
- 24. We rejoice in the triumphs, successes and blessings of others. We do not feel envious or inferior, nor are we given to feeling superior to others.
- 25. We remain true and consistent to Truth ideals under all circumstances.
- 26. We avoid trying to impose Truth ideas and principles upon others, and we do our utmost to make our own lives an example of the value of practising Truth teachings.
