Building God-consciousness



To those who are seeking the consciousness of God, I would suggest that they ask themselves the following questions: "Is there a God?" If you can answer this in the affirmative, proceed to question two: "What is He? Hatred? Sickness?

Poverty? Unhappiness? Death? Or is He the divine attributes of health, happiness, protection, prosperity, vision, and all other qualities of good?" If the latter you can go on to your third question, the most important one. "Where is He?" If you have accepted Omnipresence as a Reality this will mean that He is all the qualities of Good there are, and all the Presence there is, so that there can be nothing apart from Him; in which case, who are you? Can you be outside of All-presence? If not, is it that you are, yourselves, GOD-PRESENCE. Think about it for a moment! The Power everywhere evenly present at the same time, plus all the Good there is, IS YOU. If this is so – and it must be – there can be no room in your lives for His opposite, sickness, poverty, unhappiness, or lack of any kind. This is the logical inference following upon your answers, but are you convinced that they are correct?

I was lying awake the other night and thinking, as I always do, about the Omnipresence of God and its tremendous import, when there stole over me a wonderful sense of nearness, the understanding that all things are not only possible but certain with man because of his being Godconstituted. The only thing that prevents manifestation is the fact that man is ignorant of his true nature, and unaware of himself written with a capital "M". He is living in a state of hypnosis, in a fool's paradise of separation, sickness, misery and failure, and all that is required to transmute these negative conditions into positive ones is a knowledge of the Truth of Being, the recognition and there is not God AND self, but that when the individual says "I am" he is declaring his veritable God-or-Good-nature, which consists of health, happiness and prosperity to share and to spare.

We who are dwelling in a fool's paradise, in the consciousness of separation, bereft of all authority and command, need to be awakened from our dream. We beg, plead, meditate, visualise and pray, we do everything we possibly can to produce qualities of Good in ourselves, but they remain external to us. What authority do you possess? What does your consciousness of dominion amount to? If I say to a member of my staff, please do this or that there is no question in my mind but that he will fulfil his function and carry out my wishes. One does not have to shout, affirm or visualise, one merely says do this or that knowing that it will be done, *because one is possessed of the requisite authority*. A lot of us imagine when we approach God that it will be by means of affirmations and proclamations, accompanied by much shouting that we shall produce in our affairs the

qualities of Good we are seeking, but it does not work like that at all.

We decided that GOD IS, and when we asked ourselves what He is, we recognised that He is LOVE, so Love must exist, not as a personality, but as a Reality. It is both Creator and creation, a Divine Intelligence of Harmony and Order expressing Itself outwardly in myriads of forms. It is First Cause, omnipresent joy, health, happiness, protection, prosperity and all else we require and desire. We cannot have Love everywhere evenly present except we fit into It, but we imagine that we are made of negative qualities and that, though all around us, above us and beneath us is the Presence of God, It is not in and through us. We think we can destroy His Omnipresence with our dissent and that we are bad apples which contaminate the whole and ruin it. If this is possible, does it make sense? Of course not!

You are trying to discover what the Master asked you to *accept*. You are the temples of the living Presence of Love. Which is NOW your happiness and all that you crave, but you have to take It unto yourselves: "Concerning the works of My Hands, command ye Me." That is specific, but how are we to do it? God is not a person whom we can order about, and even if He were, He is the macrocosm, we but the microcosms, and we cannot command that which is infinitely greater than ourselves, any more than we could constrain the President as an individual, to do our chores for us. It is *His*

will, not ours, that is decisive, but we are not dealing with a personality; we are treating with Omnipresence as Love, and we command It by attuning our hearts to It. When we do this we become Omnipotence. Omniscience, and Omnipresence, the very Voice of God, of Power and Authority, so that we can say, "Let this condition in my consciousness disappear." or this flaw in my life fade out into the nothingness whence it came." Of sickness we know that it is a lie of separation and no part of God, but rather an error of our way of thinking, our own lovelessness come forth into manifestation. A lot of noise, affirmations, or the old type of prayer we were taught to pray, will not bring our good into our lives, neither will the fact that we are students attached to the School of Truth cause everything to gravitate towards us. We can be Roman Catholics, Salvation Armyists, or Bush Baptists; our religion, nationality, social position or financial status, will not affect the outcome, only the universal Power of Love. Which is us. YOU AND ME, can bring to pass for us.

Nevertheless, while we regard ourselves as God-creations instead of as Omnipresence-in-expression the hands necessary for our welfare will not open for us. This will happen only as we recognise that we are the Presence of LOVE, *then* it will be done unto us accordingly as we release It.

At times there will be, or will appear to be, tremendous physical, mental, emotional or material opposition, but this will be a lie, necessary at the particular juncture where it occurs, for the extension or expansion of our knowledge. If we sit down quietly and in the light of Omnipresence, consider the man, woman, condition or circumstance that appears to be obstructing us, we shall see that our antagonist is ourselves, for we, individually, are that presence. There is nothing outside of us: we look into the mirrors of our minds. but once we have discovered Love, It will see through us with Eyes that are too pure to behold iniquity. We are so steeped in our error-awareness that we are always expressing negation; even before we have had time to think, we automatically give way to criticism and condemnation but omnipresent Love neither censures, punishes, nor holds up our good. We do that. We build up some colossal error whose size hypnotises us until we tap ourselves on the shoulder and remind ourselves that it is not of God. Omnipresence means "Allness" so how can evil exist in Good, or darkness dwell in light?

If Love is Allness then I and all with whom I come into contact must be Allness too, therefore whatever is at the root of my distress, cannot be other than myself.

If a man comes to see me because his wife or child has caused him unhappiness, I am not concerned with them, but with him, and so it is with your troubles; they do not need to be overcome, they exist only in your personal consciousness, so it is you who have to undergo a change of heart. If instead of the husband, the wife or child comes to me, the problem is hers, or its, for whoever suffers from anything does so

because it is part of his awareness, and before God's loving Presence can come through, he will have to eliminate the socalled reality of the condition from his mind.

Once you realise that I – God am self-sufficient, you will have no enemies, nothing to hurt you, nothing to oppose you, or deprive you of your Good. There will be no person or appearances to interpose between you and your Godawareness; you will be the fullness of your own happiness, prosperity and health, achieved not by talking *but by knowing*.

It will be hard when things are going against you and you yearn for some human sympathy and companionship to have to admit that no individual can supply these, but only your own state of consciousness. It is not easy to believe that God is your prosperity when you reach the retiring age and find that you have not saved enough to pay your way, and all channels are closed to you. When sickness has invaded your bodies and there is no one to help you, a feeling of complete emptiness comes over you. But let us take the long view and admit that, if these experiences compel you to turn to Truth and engender within you a consciousness of the Power Which brought you into being as a self-sufficient entity, dependent not on individuals, but only upon GOD for your Good, they will have been well worthwhile.

If I look back on my life, I remember that the problems that were presented to me alarmed me so, that I made such a noise telling myself of God's All-presence that I could

not hear myself thinking about the condition. I had no faith and no awareness but I could not imagine the Master or any other developed soul raising a terrific clamour hoping by that means to reach the ears of God; such a one would be poised, peaceful and relaxed, knowing that Love was omnipresent health, happiness and prosperity. The empty vessel makes the most sound, and the person who lacks the consciousness of God usually tells everyone how well he knows Him, while the man who has acquainted himself with but the outer edges of the Power of Love, lives It in himself and people, seeing and recognising It, flock to him in search of the knowledge he possesses. It is not talking that impresses but the good that has been made manifest in the life of another through his confidence and conviction, proves that All-power in heaven and earth has been vested in him. Can you now believe that all the Power necessary to change yourselves mentally, emotionally, physically and materially is yours, or rather YOU? Do you accept the Truth that, at this moment, the Power of Love is permeating you with Its own qualities from the inner to the outer, from the centre to the circumference? Or are you still striving from outside of yourselves to get an answer to prayer. The Kingdom of God, Love, and His Substance is within you as well as outside of you, and you can choose the road you will take to It, certain that He will assist you in any manner you desire; but if you impose limitations upon Him these will clutter up your way. As long as you have not discovered Him you will not have

come into your inheritance, and though He will not withhold His aid, you will not have the inner conviction that God IS and because He is I (you) AM.

There are not two presences but only ONE, spiritual, emotional, mental and physical, Which is God, AND INCLUDES YOU, to whom He has said: "I have given you dominion over all things, so, concerning the works of My Hands, command ye Me. All you see around of Good – health, happiness protection or prosperity – if you bring your hearts and actions into tune with Me – is yours. You will slip on the path and tarry by the wayside; many times you will feel a sense of frustration and impotence, but always deep in your hearts you will know that in spite of the *evidence* of evil. I could not have created it."

There is only one Creator, Love, Which can fulfil Itself only according to Its own nature of Light, Understanding and Beauty. Do you want to discover this Presence for yourselves, do you want to come close to It, or do you still hanker after a crutch, some person or guarantor to act as a standby? How much do you desire God. What is the measure of your development, your consciousness of His Power? Are you content with the crumbs from the table, satisfied not to live but to exist, to have built yourselves a certain pinnacle of security which can be swept away at any time, leaving you to start all over again? Personally I would rather be dead than live from moment to moment in insecurity. There are many things I do

not know, and many I fain would understand, but I am sure of this, that if any man seeks God without compromising, he shall indeed find Him.

I am no different from the boy who leaves school for the university only to find that he must gather a great deal of information if he would solve the problems that are being presented to him there. He can grow only as the result of experience and at times it appears that adversity is the only adequate teacher; nevertheless I have often cried. "Why is the road that shall give us the awareness of our Power and drive out our sense of separation so difficult?" We fall down because we are impatient and uncontrolled, avid for things we do not deserve (since we have not yet built up the awareness of them) but we have achieved a mental treasure in the discovery that we are not able to create, but must attune ourselves to God – Love, Joy, Beauty – and allow Him to be fulfilled through us.

The conditions that pile up at times are but lies and when we bestir ourselves and put His Verities in their place, they will disappear into the void whence the came, for they have no power and no real existence. There is only God, Omnipresence, Which is Love and occupies all time and space; It is in *us* in manifestation, and when we recognise this, we shall be able to say in trust and expectation, "Let it be done. Let the Truth enter my awareness and let the lie that is now facing me be eliminated from my consciousness." There is only God sustaining us every moment unto eternity

and waiting patiently for us to recognise Him. Let us rejoice and be glad in the knowledge – not the belief – the Master unfolded to us that we are all temples of the living God, having access to His spiritual qualities, which when we release them, flow from within outwards like a quickening stream that bubbles up and brings refreshment to our hearts, minds, bodies and affairs.

When, like batteries that have run down, we become depleted, if we will turn to Him, trusting in the promise "Come seek Me with all your hearts and love, and ye shall surely find Me." We shall be recharged with His Vitality and Strength. He will ask for no return except that as we open our hearts to the Power flowing in from the inner to the outer, we begin to live It and distribute It.

You will all eventually discover that this Omnipotence is within you and that "concerning My works, mental, emotional, physical and material you shall command Me. Then will I restore unto you the years that the locusts have eaten, and you shall remember only the Good so that the dead past shall bury the dead forevermore.

"This is the Path of Truth, the way of peace and happiness and effortless success that leads to a prosperity-consciousness that will astound you as it comes into being in you, not as the result of your works, but because of My Love Which sets you free."

"Give Me all your problems, your conditions of darkness and I will flood them with My Light, and My Voice of Love shall encourage you and uplift you, My rod shall sustain and support you, and My Truth, Which is the only Truth, shall set you forever free."

Room of Joy

Some people say that we are living in an age of anxiety but for some, every age has been an age of anxiety. We persist with our fear and worry even though we are so often told how detrimental it is to our wellbeing, and knowing that we bring forth that to which we direct our energies. Those who are sensitive to their own condition feel the lowering of their state of mind and their vision of life.

Is this perennial condition of anxiety something mankind should simply accept? Is it just human nature or is there something we can do to rise above it? Perhaps more importantly, must those who are not afflicted simply learn to cope with the effect that the behaviour of others has upon them?

This negation *can* be overcome if we are prepared to direct our will and the life-giving Force within us consistently and consciously towards the positive, even if at first it may be an almost artificial optimism, acting the part. Also, we can learn to relax our bodies and minds. It has been proven that relaxation blocks the entry of negative influences into our lives. Devoting time to relaxation, as we introduce to you at The School of Truth, is far better than giving time to your fears. Only a few minutes spent each day is enough to establish the habit. We all live by habits, so we should try to make them good ones.

During our relaxations we invite Divine serenity into our lives. We do it by consciously accepting only that which is good, true, beautiful, sweet, peaceful and blissful. The Master exhorts us to "go into your room and shut the door and pray to your Father." The homes of his society did not have the luxury of personal rooms, so clearly he means that we should retreat to an inner part of our mind, away from the clamour of the world and away from our worldly reactions to that clamour. With practice we can all learn to do this – to establish a quiet room in the mind and to fill it with sights and sounds that bring us joy, with images perhaps of a sunset, a river, a mountain, a private garden. In our special room we find it easy to contemplate the most beautiful aspects of life.

To this special Room of Joy we should retire in the morning before we rise and the evening before we retire, and as often as we can even for a few moments during our busy day. We can take with us into our Room an affirmation of God's presence. Psalm 91 has several wonderful affirmations, for example "He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High will say to the Lord 'My refuge and my fortress'," At first it may require discipline but soon it becomes second nature. We do not become dreamers, detached from normal life, but become more vital, more alert in consciousness.

There is a story of a man who wanted a genie. One popped up and said to him "I will be your genie and you can have anything you desire, but there is one condition – you must keep me busy all day long. I never stop working." So the man agreed, and asked the genie to plough his fields. In a short while all the fields were ploughed. Then the man asked that a wall be built all around the fields. Again in no time the task was completed. The man asked that all his farm sheds be rebuilt and the genie started work. At this point the man realised that he had a problem. How was he going to keep the genie busy all the time? He pondered and pondered his difficulty, but to no avail. So he went to see a wise man and explained his problem. The wise man thought for a while and the said "Ask the genie to dig a big hole in the ground and in it to erect a pole. Now when he is not doing something for you ask him to slide up and down the pole. That will keep him busy at all times, and out of mischief" So that is what the man did

Now the genie is like your mind, which is a tool that never sleeps. When it is not busy with a task let it rest in the Infinite. Direct it there before you go to sleep so that it does not disturb you but fulfils itself. Even during your relaxations you may direct it there so that there is a part of you that is always attuned to ultimate Reality, to God.

There is a humorous advertisement on television which shows how the housewife, unlike her husband, is able to do several chores at once. She is like the African mother who is able to carry an object on her head while holding a conversation, directing her small children, and doing other minor tasks. All the time there is a part her mind making sure

the object stays on her head. This is how we should be with God. We practice regularly to retreat into our quiet room and then to return to life's threshold.

Negation, like everything else, is built up by constant practice. It becomes a deeply entrenched habit. How often do you meet people whose entire reality seems to rest on anxiety. They seem to be happy only when they are worrying. The best way to destroy a bad habit is to replace with a good one.

The opposite of fear is faith. We can make a habit of faith – to believe in God and constantly to practice our belief. This is not just an intellectual assent to the existence of God but living *as though* he exists, greeting each new day with love in our hearts, expecting each day to bring forth our highest good.

Each day we use our creative imagination, knowing that our consciousness creates our reality, our environment, and that our consciousness depends upon the thoughts and feelings that habitually occupy us. We need to soar above the mundane affairs of life. "Let your light so shine before men, and they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven."

We seek to perfect ourselves that we may be an inspiration and a blessing to all whom we meet. This is indeed the day the Lord has made. Let us be happy and rejoice in it.

One day thinking this over I decided it was not enough to make this declaration and leave it at that. "Supposing," I asked myself," that a certain Mrs. Smith, who envied and desired to resemble a millionairess (a Mrs. Jones) who was famous not only for her riches, but for her beauty, popularity, vitality, generosity and sunny disposition, sought to achieve this by vehemently affirming 'I am one with Mrs Jones and all that she is and has' and then continuously complained of her aches and pains, always refused any appeal for money with the excuse that she had none to spare and invariably met her fellow creatures with ill will and discourtesy. "do you." I asked myself, "imagine that her affirmation, even if reiterated the whole day through, would change her or the conditions amid which she lived?"

Now maybe *I*, Father, have not fallen quite so short as this example I quoted to myself, but I have not watched my every word and reaction as I should have done.

Many times I have repeated, not maliciously but carelessly, idle and unsubstantiated gossip about some public figure, remarking "Oh, it is common knowledge that he drinks!" Or about a well known actress. "She is *quite* a notorious character." Often I have allowed my feelings to be "hurt", have resented people, conditions and situations, and have reacted negatively in many instances *without ever realising* that all of this was diametrically opposed to You and Your Nature

Now, having taken myself to task, I see that if I would claim my oneness with Your Perfection I must think Your thoughts after You, utter only such words as the Master would have spoken, fill my heart with love and goodwill, and act solely from the standpoint of love, and for this, my Father, I need Your constant help.

I would have You remind me of Your Presence when I forget about It, jog my elbow when thoughtlessly I start to repeat or acquiesce in some unfounded tittle tattle, infuse Your LOVE into my heart and guide my every action. I will be as alert, Father, as I can be, to perceive Your leadings; and as, bit by bit, I conform MY LIVING to Your Grace I shall, I know, begin to experience my oneness with You and to see the manifestations thereof in myself and all of my affairs.

The Eternal Question

"I and My Father are one." Once again I am come up against that challenging statement upon which I have spent so much time in an earnest endeavour to make it my own.

Logically I accept it. If there *is* only God – and I admit this – there cannot be two of us, and as I certainly exist I must be included in Him as an integral part of His Being. I believe with all my intelligence that there is no separation between me and my Maker, and that consequently "all that I have is thine." But there are certain things I lack: Health for instance, others that I would have changed, my environment and associates, and still others I would wish to see increased, prosperity, success, power, so once more I reaffirm that what God is, I am; and what He has is mine also, yet where the material expressions are concerned I still find myself making no headway.

As I strive after enlightenment, this is what comes into my mind. Supposing there is a father, "A", and his son "B". They are of one flesh and the son participates in all that his father possesses.

The father is handsome, healthy, rich and successful. The son, too, is well favoured, has an excellent constitution, shares in his father's wealth, and enjoys greater stature because of his parent's prestige. Unfortunately he is personally unkempt and dirty, so that his good looks are hidden by his slovenly

appearance; he lives grossly, drinking and roistering to excess so his native robustness is undermined by his intemperate habits; he wastes and loses his money on gambling and racing so despite his affluence he is always hard up and frequently flat broke, and though his father's eminence casts its mantle over him, he is such an obvious waster that he has no social position at all. Nevertheless he *is* his father's son, and what his father *has* is his if he could receive it, but he is so abysmally divided from him as to render this impossible.

I, too am my Father's son, and in this conviction I claim the health I feel is lacking, a more desirable environment, more compatible associates, greater prosperity, increased success, and added power, but am *I*, while declaring my atonement with Him, falling – not into the same blatant mistakes as "B" – but into others that, like his, are so opposed to all that God is that they do cut me off completely *in awareness* from Him so that I also am precluded from entering the Kingdom for as long as I continue in my separation-consciousness.

I declare daily that, because of my unity with Him. His GOOD is mine, but I do not demonstrate, so I start to search still deeper in my heart. I find that I am very intolerant of the weaknesses I, all too readily, pick out in my fellowmen. I realise that I am often cuttingly critical, usually quick to anger and slow to give, and that I am inclined to denigrate those who displease me. In short *I am anything but charitable*, so am I not as much at variance with the LOVE THAT IS GOD as was "B" out of character with his parent?

He undoubtedly *was* his father's heir, but he could not, because of his own nature, of the faults with which he had *overlaid* his sonship, enter into his heritage. Am I not likewise depriving myself of "all that I have" because I, too, am making myself, through the failings I have superimposed on God's image and likeness, incapable of receiving my ALL-GOOD?

If this so – and I do not for a moment doubt it – my course is plain. I must, for the present, cast aside my hard-won intellectual realisation of man's at-one-ment with his Maker, and it is that cold, reasoned conviction which I have been trying to make "work" for me, and must start out from the beginning with my heart instead of my head.

As I contemplate the illimitable GOODNESS of this Father of mine, the urge must spring up within me to repay, in some slight measure, His Bounty – and with what? *Just with my LOVE*.

I must take a much broader view of the unity I have been claiming, and extend it to encompass not only those near and dear to me, but all mankind. I must think God's thoughts after Him, seeing, hearing and speaking no evil, and must act only to the glory of His Name, forgiving and helping all men and, putting them before myself. I must do unto them as I would they should do unto me. Then when, at last, I can see His likeness in every passing face and LOVE it, I shall be ready to declare from both my heart and head that, because He and

I are one, all that He has is mine and to see it come forth into manifestation in, through, and to me.

The last named are the reliable ones to whom others turn in time of stress.

If you are easily upset determine that from today you will be different. Learn to relax and to face difficult situations calmly. If you find yourself giving way to anger or panic, turn to God for a moment and shed all your tenseness. Know that no situation presents any difficulty to Him, and put the matter in His hands, knowing that He will resolve the discord. Say: "I stand still this day and see the salvation of God."
