Plenteous of Good



I frequently ask people what, if they are still unfulfilled, is the most urgent need in their lives. Some say they want health, others plump for happiness, and for seven out of ten prosperity seems to be the most important thing. "Give me

money," they say, "for with it I shall be able to buy all the things I need, plus the extra luxuries I would like to have." I shake my head sadly because I know that any man who, even with great wealth, is lacking in health and happiness is a beggar indeed.

If you were to ask *me* what I want, I would reply, "An idea, the very clear idea of who and what I am, and of what my function here on earth is." I see too many who are square pegs in round holes. Some having money are miserable, others are happy, but poor, and many have health unallied to happiness. That is why I would ask for a knowledge of my own identity, because I realise intuitively that with that idea firmly implanted in me, everything would have to fall into place. Like the little pieces in a jig-saw puzzle they would form a composite picture, in my case of health, happiness and security.

I know, as most of us do, that God created man, but I want something deeper than a superficial acceptance of an obvious

fact, the INNER REALISATION of the Truth of all Being, and in answer to my cry He replies, "Listen to My Voice and I will be your plenteous Good." Is this some being in the sky, a person to whom I must listen? As I ponder this, the realisation comes over me that my voice is His Voice, for there is but one Presence existing, and that one HIS, and MINE too, because there is no separation between the Creator and His created. Consequently, I listen to what I have to say for Good from the moment when I awaken in the morning to the time when I drop off to sleep when day is done. In the interim I have much to think about, knowing that He is talking only of that which is Perfection. Of disease He says, "That is a lie, Health is a Verity, as is Harmony, but unhappiness is an illusion." Can there be a consciousness of poverty while He is Prosperity, complete Security? In the watches of the night I talk to myself asking myself if perhaps it is He who is speaking through me. If my words are those of poverty, sickness, error, negation and lies, then it is not God who is uttering them, for they are not in tune with that which is perfection.

As the years roll by this vision of Him who is talking through me gets stronger, more authoritative. The recognition builds up in me that this Presence, which constitutes the entire universe, is unlimited in the visible and the invisible and that the more I talk about His Good to myself and others, the greater will become my consciousness of cosmic oneness. Then, looking at my hands, and yours, I can say with conviction that they, each with its small fingers, are His.

Does that seem possible to you? Can the span of a human hand contain creation? It can, and it does, for those seeming physical hands, if they are open, can never be empty, limited or circumscribed; only if they are closed – in fear – in an effort to "hold on" – can the Infinite Presence (as far as the individual awareness is concerned) be squeezed out of them. I can see whether these hands of mine are open or shut and as, deliberately, I keep them open so that the Universal Presence of God may flow freely through them, my realisation of (not belief in) their inborn Abundance becomes deeper and deeper. I cannot give with my hands – which are only the vehicles of God's bestowing and receiving – if my mind and emotions are bound in fear.

As I think along these lines, I can discern who – in spite of your conditions, problems and restrictions – you and I are, and in every talk, I have with people about their difficulties, I literally beg them to GIVE AWAY their fear. I try to convince them that they are holding on to nothingness as they shut out the Presence of Omniscience and Omnipotence which is longing to become in and through them their health, happiness and prosperity, in no niggardly measure but in unlimited amplitude to share and to spare. Because I know of this, I do not ask for qualities or things.

Many years ago, His Voice said through me, to me, "No limit has been imposed upon you (or any other human being). Whatever you want to give, you can give, so screw

your courage to the sticking point and begin distributing and releasing. Often at first you may be frightened by conditions, obstructions will loom so large that you will think they cannot be overcome but *let nothing you dismay*. Continue your giving for the measure thereof will be the gauge of the understanding you have of My Self-expressing in you, through you and AS you."

With this in mind I did not stop, and the idea has proved itself (as it became an externalised Reality), so what you need is an IDEA, not a "thought" which is just the manifestation of an idea. A home is the idea of love, a car an idea of comfort, books an idea of reading and intelligence. You have to find the spiritual prototype of what you want and then to ask for it to manifest itself. You don't, of course, dictate as to how it shall come about.

The other night the question was put to me, "Do you think it will be for the good of all concerned if I ask God for this idea?" and I replied that everything that comes from Him comes under grace and in a perfect way – that is, with no sorrow added. He does not give with one hand and take away with the other. There is no lack of God in any life, and He does not withdraw Himself into such a high rate of vibration that we cannot contact Him. We fail to demonstrate only because we are lacking in the steadfastness that does not give up. Knowledge follows upon persistency of purpose; until you have tried something out, you cannot experience it.

Think for a moment that your body has within it the unlimited wealth that is God in whatever form you need it, and that when you listen to His Voice those riches will come into being for you. In the Bible we read, "Hearken unto the Voice of Jehovah, and He will give you plenteous of good." I put it into modern language and say, "Listen to the Voice of God and He will express His plenteous Good in you, through you and AS you."

It is for you to begin as I did to listen to what *you* say, which – if you are in contact with God – will be the Divine Idea you need, but if you are merely babbling negatively you will not receive anything because you will have been hearkening to the voice of nothingness.

One simple idea is all you require in order to make your material fortune with the spiritual attributes of health, joy and fearlessness added, but for this to happen you must be attuned to God. If I put my hand in my pocket and find that there is nothing there, I shall – by becoming sad and dejected – transfer that emptiness to my heart, but I shall not create it, for nothingness is merely an illusion, it is not a problem or a structure. I can look at it and if I view it in terms of integration with God, I shall see His idea come forth into fulfilment as Good, but if I look at it in terms of separation from Him, this too will externalise itself as loss, poverty and insecurity.

We all listen to the Voice of God the whole day long; we never stop so doing, but we have *ourselves* to think, feel

and speak constructively if we want Good to persist in our lives. We have to watch our hands, to test these Hands of God, which are never found to be wanting. The problems and difficulties we meet come to stimulate us, to force us to seek a broader vision, and to expand our consciousness. God can work only through us, so it is we who must release ever more and more of His Substance

Many are called but few are chosen, not because God does not choose them, but because when they have achieved a certain degree of understanding, or consciousness, they start to panic, fearing that Truth will not work beyond that particular point. When you set out it is not so difficult, you have a Path, you realise that you are on an adventure with God, but when you fall by the wayside and give up, you feel that you have let Him down, and it is not easy to climb back. We put our hands to the plough, but the effort is too great, we tire and give up. It is a strain to think, speak, feel and act constructively all day long, but that is what we are here for. In any case, we cannot stop this process, we can only change its direction from the positive to the negative, so let us listen to His Voice of Good, speak with It, and act with His Hands. If we do so the world and all that's in it will be ours and we, the man in the street, the members of every Church, the black, brown, white and yellow shall have access to every Spiritual Idea in whatever form we and they need It. It is the spoken word of Good which releases the Idea, building It up into consciousness, or knowledge.

The other day someone asked me what consciousness meant and I replied, "If I banged a big drum with my fist, would you hear it?" "Of course I should," was the answer. "Well," I said, "you would be conscious of the noise, you would experience it, *know* it. So it is with Truth. Consciousness is an inner realisation of the quality you need, so will you think about this and prove it for yourself as you listen to the Voice of God who shall be your PLENTEOUS OF GOOD."

The "Single" Eye



The other day I was asked by a woman who had been unable to attend one of my lectures to give one specifically for her, and when I asked her on what she wanted me to speak, she replied, "I want everything."

Like most other people she was being misled by appearances for, could she have understood the meaning of Omnipresence, she would have known that she already *had* everything."

We all yearn for fulfilment and, while crying out for everything, we experience lack of some description; yet the Spirit of God within us is ever inviting us to partake, not just of the things we want, but of all that He is and has.

Because the same idea of negation of which the Master spoke, comes to us as He does to you, I know it is not easy to realise God's indwelling when you are sick and unhappy or unable to pay your debts, but we all have to choose whom we will serve, or in whom or what we will put our trust.

The majority of folk imagine that it is very difficult to build up faith. They point to their neighbours who are sick, poor and unhappy, who are out of jobs, and they note that in every sphere of life there is evidence, not of good but of its opposite, and they assume that it is the will of God that is manifesting in this way. The few people who enjoy health, peace and prosperity have attained a certain state of awareness and God's GOOD just pours out to, through and for them, but for the most part people succumb to the herd, or sheep, instinct. We believe the evidence of our senses and hold that what always has formed part of the lives of individuals will continue to do so because – obviously – it must be Reality. But throughout time we have had men – the last of whom was the MASTER – who denied the reality of conditions and drew the attention of the various races to the fact that these evils did not take their rise in THE WILL OF GOD which is that mankind have fulfilment and All-good.

The Father externalises through man as his spiritual mind, emotional nature, physical body and material affairs, so when you have Him, you have all His Fullness. He is, however, unable to release Himself and though He tries to influence men through the longing in their hearts and to draw them away from appearances and conditions that they may enter the Kingdom WITHIN THEMSELVES He neither coerces nor forces them in any way. He does not compel them to be good, or evil, moral or immoral, rich or poor, happy or miserable, sick or well; the choice is theirs and theirs alone.

If you look into your own minds you will see that you lack certain amenities, not because God is withholding them, not because they are beyond your conceiving, or you have not earned the consciousness of them, but because you are looking at things, circumstances and people from the OUTSIDE and declaring the testimony of your senses to be true, when the Master and all the other great teachers have categorically stated the contrary.

What are your reactions as Truth students to what you read in the Press? Do you feel that these daily publications are leading you into a consciousness of the Power and Presence of God, or do they give you the impression that they want unhappy events to occur and as many people as possible to read about them?

Any intelligent man with the slightest knowledge of psychology recognises the impact this sort of thing has on the masses. They read it avidly, absorb it and then come to our offices throughout the country and tell us how bad things are, how much worse they will become and warn us that we shall have to face facts instead of, like ostriches, burying our heads in the sand.

The same papers also publish – certainly in very small print – quotations from the Bible: "Wherefore do ye doubt, O ye of little faith?", "with God all things are possible," adding "God is an ever-present help," "God loves you, you have nothing to fear," and I ask myself whether this is done, tongue

in cheek, because it pleases some readers or whether there is a genuine desire behind it to draw the attention of the public away from lies, appearances, conditions and circumstances and to focus it upon the Eternal Verities.

Which would you say were true, the statements "Ask, and ye shall receive," "Whatsoever ye pray for, believe you have received it and you shall have it," "It is the Father's good pleasure to give you the Kingdom," or the bold, black lettering declaring that bad times are manifesting and will continue to do so?

I want to discover the effect such statements have on *you* – some impact there must have been – and most probably it is an unhappy one, and it is therein that the danger lies. Precisely as darkness cannot enter light, so nothing can affect Omnipotence and Omniscience UNLESS WE CONSTANTLY open our minds to it, putting on the switch of our understanding and seeing, for all and sundry, not GOOD but the bad, fear, poverty, insecurity and unemployment.

This fear-consciousness is like a camera taking photographs of nothing because nothing is something which does not exist and if the Presence of God is Omnipresence, there cannot be such a quality as nothingness *except in our awareness* where no-health, no-happiness, no-prosperity prevails.

When we develop our film and throw it upon a screen, we are amazed to find nothing being projected and ask ourselves whether there can be nothingness in our lives; yet when there IS nothing in the consciousness of the individual the people are *without vision* and perish, for nothing has been developed.

To be constructive is to be productive. If your awareness has something in it, if you have an understanding of the Presence of God, in whom you live, move and have your being as He lives, moves and exists through you, the whole world can topple about you while you remain *untouched*, otherwise it would not be God, Who is All-power, All-presence and All-knowledge, but conditions, circumstances and personalities.

You have to become realists, and to build into your awareness the Truth that EVERYTHING THAT IS GOD, EVERYTHING THAT IS GOOD, CONSTITUTES YOU AND ME. Are you following the lies, circumstances, conditions, people, who deny the Presence of God and draw you along the path of emptiness, fear, un-fulfilment and extinction; or do you believe in the Truths of life in the Living Presence, in the spiritual fact that He is ALL POWER and above situations and events?

You simply *have* to make up your minds about this, for there are tens of thousands in this country who are doing so from the negative point of view (we meet them and receive many letters a day confirming this) and both you and I must be able to say. "I know in whom I believe," for then He will literally become our Protection and nothing and nobody will be able to interpose between us and our Good save with our permission.

If there were a maniac at your door, hammering on it with a chopper, although you might panic at the *idea* of what could happen, you would know that as long as he was unable to force it open, you would be safe; but what do we as temples of GOD do? We hear, see and feel the bombardment of lies and error from without, but instead of keeping the doors closed, we open the doors of our minds and fear rushes in. You can sense it, for the fear in the minds of all those thinking in such terms, finds an inlet into your emotions where it grips you, makes your confused and incapable of reasoned or controlled judgement, and it is by your own invitation that this destructive element, which brings unhappiness, poverty and disease with it, enters your lives.

A young Jewish lad who has been living in dread of cancer for a long time came to see me the other day. Two days ago he had a sensation of pain in his tongue, so he went to see friend of his, a specialist, who jokingly told him, "You may have a cancer" though no such condition existed. I am sure you will agree that that was a criminal thing to do, but if you think further you will realise that the boy did not *have* to believe it. No one needs to accept what is told to him, or even what his own senses maintain, for the things we see are lies of the human consciousness, denials of the fact that God IS you and IS me, not a separate entity within *you or me, but His very Presence in Being in us* which has not given us "a spirit of fear, but of TRUTH, power and a sound mind"

The Master who knew mankind so well, told us to keep our eyes single to the good, and to give no power to conditions, saying when the ideas of Negation come, I do not accept "these material errors", therefore they retreat into the void from which they came.

We have to see as He saw, knowing that you cannot bring darkness into light; and seeing the seeming reality of what we hear and behold, we have to pray – as He directed – "without ceasing." That is what I do, my mind is never empty of prayer; none of our minds *is*, but some pray negatively in terms of fear, and others constructively in terms of understanding, and when we stop thinking, feeling, and acting constructively, the lie slinks in, in the form of a condition, circumstance or personality and is then very difficult to dislodge.

If you look back into history, you will see the tremendous strides that science has made through the years. Every scientist, whether he knows it or not, is the mathematical Mind of God functioning through him, yet would you say we have kept pace spiritually with our scientific achievements?

Consider your friends, neighbours, business competitors, your fathers, mothers, children, and ask yourselves whether you do not see in them the fears, jealousies and unhappiness that have been manifested throughout the whole of the last twenty centuries, in spite of the "good tidings of great joy" that the Master brought to the world.

How far have we advanced? These things are the very opposite of God, or Truth. Was then the Master's a voice crying in the wilderness, something that comes in one ear and goes out the other or was His Message something that we have accepted as a basic way of living, by means of which we can overcome the lying conditions in our lives and in those of our fellows?

How much does it mean to you, personally? Are you as sure of it as you are of the laws of mathematics, electricity and gravitation? These we have made part of our daily lives in which we see thousands of proofs of their un-changeability yet the greatest of all Laws, that of GOD who brought us into being, we work on in a hit and miss manner for we do not pray constructively *without ceasing*. We are like the young boy I mentioned who allowed something that was not even happening to become an integral part of his mind.

Are we about to be equally stupid and to listen to the propaganda of error instead of to that of Truth? You are the temples of the living God, therefore the Kingdom of the Sum Total of GOOD is within both you and me, but we have to set it free. We have to stand firm! Our armour of protection, our shield, is our knowledge of the Truth that God is All-presence and consequently constitutes us and all men. He is Omniscience, so He knows exactly how to bring His Perfection into being in your hearts, minds and bodies; and because He is the one Irresistible Force there can be no

immovable condition, object, or circumstance opposed to

Do you see how tremendous our responsibility is? Are we glorifying Him, or denying Him? *He* is not affected by what we do, *but we are*. Let us therefore take heed of the Master's assurance that we have nothing to fear lest we become part of the herd and are led aimlessly into nothingness, unaware – because of our own stupidity – of what lies before us.

Let us awaken to the fact that "God's in His Heaven and all's right with our world" because it is His omnipresent, omniscient, omnipotent LOVE and WILL, *this day* to be to us, and all peoples, the Kingdom of All Good here in His visible world.

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For Thou Art God within this body, life immortal that shall not perish, thou art the truth and the joy forever.

Watch your words



Most of us use words far too carelessly. How often do we say to someone; "You're looking very tired today;" or: "Is anything the matter? You don't look very well." And such remarks are not at all helpful – quite the reverse. Even the perfectly fit

person may start to wonder if anything is wrong with him when someone says: "You're getting thinner by the day;" or: "You've put on a lot of weight, haven't you?" when he doesn't belong to the lean kind! The trouble with many people is that they do not realise, or they do not pause to think, what effect their words may be causing; or of the power of suggestion as well as that of words. The sooner they learn these things the better for all concerned. Even those of us who have been studying Truth for years are liable to fall from grace, for habit is hard to kill. We say: "I can't afford it," for example; or: "I don't feel well," The very fact that we utter these sentences imposes them on our unconscious minds and is liable to make an impression.

Instead of using such phrases why do we not say: "I am the child of a wealthy Father;" or: "Thank You, Father, for my health"? We are then impressing the unconscious with positive ideas instead of negative ones. All that we require has already been provided for us in the realm of Spirit, and OUR FAITH brings it into manifestation. With regard to health, in our true being we are Spirit, and Spirit is perfect, so when we thank God for health, we are making a statement of Truth.

There are people who seem to be resigned to the fact that they are unsuccessful. "I was never meant to make money," they may say. Well, if that is the way they think and talk they can hardly be surprised if they are not prosperous, can they? They are lying down and allowing failure to overtake them, instead of facing it and overcoming it. How can anyone say that he was never meant to succeed? How could any loving father, if he were normal, not want his child to be a success? Then how much more must success be the desire of our heavenly Father for all of us.

We are constantly giving students positive affirmations to use. Emile Coué in his book, 'My Method' has this to say of his famous affirmation: "Leave it to the subconscious. Avoid all effort. When you recite your phrase: 'Every day, in every way, I am getting better and better,' you must relax all strain and tension. Do not seek to concentrate your thoughts. Concentration is very valuable and necessary when conscious reasoning is to be done, but fatal to the success of autosuggestion. Isolate yourself from everything likely to distract your attention, however. Close your eyes if possible... Do not think you must STRUGGLE to impose your suggestion. The very fact of making it an effort will bring into play the conscious will, and that will actually raises a barrier between the subconscious and the suggestion and prevents the latter from penetrating."

We try to be even more positive than Coué was. We would use an affirmation to this effect: "I thank You, Father, that I express Your perfection now and always." We phrase our affirmations from the spiritual angle, not only from the mental, though man's mind is a very limited expression of Divine Mind. We believe in claiming all our needs directly from the Supreme Being, not in material form but in its spiritual equivalent. Nevertheless the same principles prevail as Coué laid down. We should not try to use force in our thinking or speaking – we should not try to WILL things to happen. We should be relaxed.

The purpose of this article is to point out how careful we should be in our speech; and how wrong it is to make negative or destructive statements regarding ourselves or others. By our words we shall be justified and by our words we shall be condemned. Also that death and life are in the power of the tongue; and that the tongue of the wise is health. Then let us think carefully before we speak, that our words may bring only what is good to us and to all mankind.

A positive stand



Do you have any doubts but that God desires for you all good, or that His purpose is not fulfilled? I think you must be clear on this; certainly, if you are a student of Truth the teaching you have received will have left you with no doubts in

the matter.

Imagine now that you have a young family of two, a boy and a girl, what would your wishes, plans and hopes be for those children? Almost certainly for "more and better" than you have yourself experienced – more security, better health, higher achievements, a greater measure of happiness, all round success. There would be no grudging in your heart, no thought of withholding as your love (that of a parent) would be entirely unselfish and would prompt you only to give. You, too, have a Parent, one that is your Father which is in Heaven, and you have learned, on very good Authority, that He knows what things you have need of and is not only willing but able to supply them.

Are you harbouring any such erroneous idea as that your love for your offspring is greater than is God's for His entire creation, including you? And could you, who have very little power in your hands, possibly provide more for them than God who is Omniscience and Omnipotence has made available to you?

It might conceivably prove difficult for you who are only a limited human being to bring all your plans for your young family to fruition. July 1 Monday

♦ Your Father knoweth what things ye have need of, before ye ask Him. — Matt 6:8.

THANK YOU, FATHER, FOR SUPPLYING MY EVERY NEED.

Is there something you require urgently? And can you see no possible way in which it can come to you? Put your trust in God.

Affirm that what you need is already yours, and give thanks as a sign of faith as well as gratitude. But you must play your part in order to bring what you require into manifestation; and your part is to have faith and also to be sure that what you want will not harm another if you receive it.

The Biblical promise is that God will supply our needs if we seek first His Kingdom and righteousness. There is usually something we must do if the promises are to be fulfilled. Some people appear to succeed in the worldly sense although they are not living the Good Life, but are they happy? And of what value is success unless it brings us joy?

July 2 Tuesday

◆ Be strong and of good courage; be not affrighted, neither be thou dismayed. – Josh. 1:9.

GOD IS WITH ME, I HAVE NOTHING TO FEAR.

Have you something to do today the thought of which makes you almost sick with nervousness?

Suppose you have to interview someone with a view to being employed by him. You are thinking, probably, of the many other people who will be applying for the position. Possibly you are unsure of your ability to make a success of it if you do get it. If this is the case square your shoulders and hold up your head. If you look timid and uncertain you will affect your interviewer with uncertainty. Remember that God goes with you, give thanks for His help, and leave the outcome to Him. If we want to succeed in life, we must have the will to win. We must say: "I can," instead of "I can't." Our intelligence is part of the Divine Intelligence, so let us give thanks that It expresses Itself in us and through us now and always.

Do not blame circumstances or people if your environment is not what you would like it to be. Make the best of it for the time being but make up your mind that with the help of the Power within you, you will change it.


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
